Diagnosis:

Diseases	Infected animals	Notice
Tympany	Camels	Due to extremely feeding on bread and corn
Old wound& Abscess	Camels	Due to working in tourism and accumulation of sand between skin and saddle, falling down or clash.
Pregnancy toxemia	goats	Due to malnutrition of animals during pregnancy (decrease calcium & magnesium)
Mastitis	goats	Appear in season of pregnancy and birth
